

On Sunday 12th May we will be taking over Belper Town FC to offer girls from all sections an opportunity to play football.

The day will start with the teaching of football skills, dribbling, passing, penalty taking etc. There will be an opportunity at lunchtime to watch some football videos and take a stroll around the marketplace we are hoping to have. In the afternoon there will be a knockout tournament for each section (Rainbows, Brownies, Guides, Rangers) with a prize for the winning team!

Members who are taking part will not need any special kit - comfy clothes and a pair of trainers will be fine. Football boots are not to be worn to keep it fair for all taking part. As this is the first time we have tried an event of this type, the numbers are limited to 100 participants. We appreciate that this could lead to disappointment, however if successful we will be able to increase the numbers next time.


The Stroke Association- challenge pack
