



Safe Space & DBS Compliance - Please do make sure that the units in your district are aware that they need to have someone with a level 3 Safe Space qualification on any unit meeting, even virtual ones keep an eye on Safe Space levels 1 & 2 and DBS compliance to ensure that no-one gets caught out with a sanction or stuck as active pending because they haven't completed it. If you need some support please do ask your Area commissioner or drop a message in the DC WhatsApp group.
