This does mean that we will have to prioritise units where there is no First Response or it is about to expire, so all Eventbrite bookings will be provisional until your place is confirmed by the office team. In this spirit, it would be really helpful if you do not book multiple members of the same unit team on session.

With a team of five participants, supported by a Leader with previous GOLD experience, GOLD projects work with a Member Organisation of WAGGGS on a specific area of developing guiding. You might run leadership skills training, develop a recruitment strategy, set up a new section or lead workshops on body confidence. Teams travel to their host country for 3 weeks, or recent GOLD projects have been delivered virtually due to travel restrictions. A mixture of face-to-face and virtual projects is expected in 2023.
